

SPECIAL MEETING

City Hall, Marysville, Kansas, April 30, 2016

Members of the governing body of the City of Marysville were called to order in special meeting at 2:00 p.m., on the date and at the place noted above with Mayor Grund in the chair.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, council members answering present to roll call were: Besinger, Boss, Ekiss, Frye, Gross and Throm. Absent: Beikman and Schroller. A quorum was present.

The call, signed by the six council members present, read as follows:

We, the undersigned councilmembers of the City of Marysville hereby respectfully request that you call a special council meeting of the members of the governing body of said City to be held at 2:00 p.m. on April 30, 2016 in the council chambers at City Hall for the following purpose: To consider, discuss and/or act upon the following: a). Executive Session to discuss non-elected personnel and b). Scheduling for future special meetings.

EXECUTIVE SESSION. CM Ekiss moved, CM Boss seconded to recess in executive session pursuant to the non-elected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to conduct an interview with a city administrator candidate. This will include the Mayor and City Council and John Benson. The executive session will begin at 2:04 p.m. and the open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 3:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

At 3:00 p.m., Mayor Grund called the meeting back to order and reported no action was taken.

At 3:00 p.m., CM Gross moved, CM Frye seconded to recess in executive session pursuant to the non-elected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to conduct an interview with a city administrator candidate. This will include the Mayor and City Council and John Benson. The executive session will begin at 3:01 p.m. and the open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 3:20 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

At 3:20 p.m., Mayor Grund called the meeting back to order and reported no decisions were made.

At 3:20 p.m., CM Frye exited the council chambers.

At 3:20 p.m., CM Throm moved, CM Besinger seconded to recess in executive session pursuant to the non-elected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to conduct an interview with a city administrator candidate. This will include the Mayor and City Council and John Benson. The executive session will begin at 3:22 p.m. and the open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 3:45 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

At 3:45 p.m., Mayor Grund called the meeting back to order and reported no decisions were made. Council discussed the availability for future special sessions. Consensus of the council was to call special sessions at noon on May 3, 2016 and May 6, 2016.
